Rules & Regulations

❖ Code of Conduct

- Courteous, modest & diplomatic attitude is expected from all delegates at all times.
- Any type of harassment, illegal or harmful behaviour will not be tolerated and strict disciplinary actions will be taken.
- Delegates should carry their College ID Card and Payment Receipt at all times.
- In special cases, security checks can be conducted by either NDC's Security Teams, or NDIURC Members, or both. All Delegates are expected to cooperate.

❖ Prohibitions

- No bags (including Backpacks, Packages, Handbags, Rucksacks, College Bag) are allowed in the conference. In case the delegate brings laptop, he'll be allowed to take a laptop bag inside the premises after security checks.
- Possession of Drugs, Medicines, Alcoholic Beverages, Vape/E-Cigarettes, Cigarettes, Lighter, Match Box, Knife, Flammable Objects, and sharp objects are NOT allowed.
- Delegates are NOT allowed to leave the conference without prior permission from EBs and NDIURC's designated representative/s.

❖ Working Language

- All types of Formal Conversation, Documentations and Debates should be done in English.

❖ Dress Code

- Formal & Semi-Formal Attires are expected from the delegates at all times.
- NDIURC encourages Semi-Formal Attires for the recent weather conditions.
- Delegates CAN NOT wear the following in any conditions:
 - Sneakers, Sandals, Running/Sports Shoes
 - Jeans Pants, and 3-Quarter/Half Pants of any clothing.
 - Fancy Shirts, T-shirts, Sleeveless Clothings
 - Any type of clothings/accessories that may look odd, or unprofessional.
